For the month of April hosted 44,335 website visitors. 32.8% was from organic SEO efforts. Top visitors were from Atlanta, Orlando, Chicago, Tallahassee and Nashville.

There were 126 newsletter signups, 104 request for places to stay and 300 visitor guide request. The new visitor guide was uploaded to the website on April 12, and has already received 143 reads, 317 impressions and has an average read time of 3.1 minutes.

Social media higlights include the video produced by Alex Caputo, a teen visitor from Georgia. It reached over 15,000 people without any financial commitment. Tana received permission from the parents and the minor to share is video.
